SUNDAY SCHOOL STUDY OUTLINE

APRIL 26, 2026

THEME: FULFILLING OUR OBLIGATIONS FOR FAMILY AND COMMUNITY.

TOPIC: THE CHRISTIAN HOME IN A MODERN WORLD.

TEXT: DEUTERONOMY 6:3-9; MATTHEW 19:3-9.

MEMORY VERSE: These commandments that I give you today are to be upon your hearts. Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. **DEUTERONOMY 6:6-7.**

INTRODUCTION: Today's lesson aims to explore how we can uphold the principles of the Christian faith within our homes to ensure that we remain steadfast during shifting cultural tides and explore how to strengthen our families through God's teachings to help us survive in this modern life.

A. IMPRESSING GOD'S WORD IN A MODERN HOME.

DEUTERONOMY 6:3-9

The passage begins with a call to listen attentively to God's commands and obey as they enter Promised Land (v. 3). This reveals the importance of intentional commitment to God's teaching in order to overcome modern distraction and secular influences. Children should be exposed to spiritual education when sitting at home, walking, lying down and getting up. Faith can be applied anywhere and in any circumstance (v. 8-9) it should be intentionally applied in family interactions.

- Why do you think that it is important for families to listen to and obey God's commands? How can we practice this in our daily lives? Deut. 6:3b, 7-9
- How can we integrate discussions about faith into our everyday activities, like meals or car rides? Psalms 119:15

PRACTICAL LESSON: As Christian families, we can be sure that God's word is not only part of our lives today but be handed down to the future generation.

B. GOD'S DESIGN FOR MARRIAGE.

MATTHEW 19:3-9

One of the challenges facing the home in these modern times is divorce. Marriage is a sacred union established before the fall of man. It is intended to be a lifelong commitment between a man and a woman. Jesus emphasized on the hardness of their hearts which led to the permissive Law of Moses concerning divorce. Jesus reaffirms that the Ideal is an unbroken covenant relationship. This serves as a charge for Christian couples to examine their marriage and relationships with a focus on maintaining unity and partnership. Instead of resorting to divorce, they are urged to seek divine assistance and understanding.

- Discuss ways in which spouses are demonstrating hardheartedness in making their marital conflicts irresolvable.
- Highlight possible post-divorce challenges and their implications on the spouses and their children Ephesians 5:22-33.

PRACTICAL LESSON: Christian couple should first remember their first love and resolve any conflicts that may want to raise its head instead of thinking of divorce because God hates it. Malachi 2:13-16.
