I welcome all Jubilant Youths to this year's Youth Week of the Nigerian Baptist Convention with the theme "**Explore**" Gen 13:14-18.

As we explore God's purpose for our lives, we must remember that purpose is not a competition. In today's world, many young people feel pressured by what their friends have achieved, what social media portrays, or even the expectations of parents and society. However, God's plan for each person is unique, and His timing is perfect. Abraham did not become the father of many nations overnight; David was anointed king long before he sat on the throne. Their journeys teach us that purpose unfolds according to God's schedule, not human pressure.

SUNDAY SCHOOL STUDY OUTLINE

JUNE 7, 2026

THEME: FAITHFUL WITNESSES TESTIFY TO GOD'S PROMISES.

TOPIC: A LEADER IN A NATIONAL EMERGENCY.

TEXT: JUDGES 4:4-10, 14, 21-22

MEMORY VERSE: Now Deborah, a prophet, the wife of Lappidoth, was leading Israel at that time. She held court under the Palm of Deborah between Ramah and Bethel in the hill country of Ephraim, and the Israelites went up to her to have their disputes decided. **JUDGES 4:4-5.**

INTRODUCTION

One of the major problems in our nation today is the issue with good leadership and it has been our society's bane for a long time. In today's lesson, our focus is on Deborah who was not power hungry. Her life as an exceptional leader is a challenge to us to lead the people with wisdom and the fear of God.

A. DEBORAH COMMISSIONED BARAK

JUDGES 4:4-10

The story of Deborah shows that a woman can be an effective leader, provided God is backing her up! She should possess a good character with charisma, courage with competence and conviction with commitment. God goes before us, preparing the way in every assignment He gives us. He puts everything in place and ensures our success as long as we follow His leading.

- What are the reason(s) why Barak refused to go to the battle unless Deborah would go with him.
- Specify ways to prevent gender or other forms of discrimination against God's leaders in our churches today. Rom. 10:12, Gal. 3:28, Rom. 3:22

PRACTICAL LESSON: Whatever success we record should be credited to God who gives us the enablement.

B. THE ASSURANCE OF VICTORY

JUDGES 4:14

Deborah consistently assured Barak of victory by telling him to take a bold step to confront the enemy (vv. 6; 14). She assured him that the Lord had gone ahead to fight the battle for him, and had delivered his enemy into his hands. Barak was not to rely on the strength of his men, but on the Lord.

- How can we encourage one another in facing the challenges of life just as we have seen it played out in today's lesson? Heb. 3:13, 1Thess.4:18, 1Thess. 5:11
- How can we encourage church leaders to create and sustain interdependence and shared responsibility to accomplish the purpose of God without gender bias?

PRACTICAL LESSON: When God is involved in our battles, we should rest assured that the battle is won already.

C. THE FULFILMENT OF DEBORAH'S PROPHECY

JUDGES 4:21-22

By divine mandate, an ally suddenly turned into an enemy as Jael, the wife of Heber, took a tent peg and a hammer in her hand, went softly to him and drove the peg into his temple to kill him. How could a woman summon courage and strength to drive a tent peg through the temple of a sleeping warrior? All this happened to fulfil Deborah's prophecy that God would receive the glory through a woman.

- Discuss how Jael's actions brought about the fulfilment of prophecy.
- In what ways can we know that God's prophecies are being fulfilled in our lives?

PRACTICAL LESSON: God's plan will surely come to pass in the lives of His children.
