SUNDAY SCHOOL STUDY OUTLINE

JULY 26, 2026

THEME: FAITHFUL WITNESSES SAY "YES" TO JESUS CHRIST.

TOPIC: MARY, THE MOTHER OF JESUS.

TEXT: LUKE 2:15-19, JOHN 2:1-5; 19:25-27.

MEMORY VERSE: But Mary treasured all these things and pondered them in her heart **LUKE 2:19.**

INTRODUCTION

Today's lesson will take us through the life of Mary, the mother of Jesus, and how she lived the life she never planned for. This lesson will teach us how to cope with situations beyond us as faithful witnesses of Christ who are willing to say "yes" to His will even when it hurts.

A. MARY'S REFLECTION.

LUKE 2:15-19

Following the shepherds' visit and the angelic announcement, everyone marvels at the miracle and eagerly share the news of Jesus' arrival. Mary's response as noted in verse 19, reveals her profound ability to nurture the prophecies written concerning Jesus. Her ability invites us to consider how we respond to God's revelations in our lives.

- What will you say about Mary's secretive attitude?
- Why is it important to keep some things secret until their manifestation? Prov. 21:23, Prov. 13:3, Prov. 17:27-28.

PRACTICAL LESSON: Just as Mary, we are called to reflect deeply on our encounters with the divine and the responsibilities that follows

B. MARY'S WITNESS ABOUT JESUS.

JOHN 2:1-5

Weddings in the Near Eastern world usually last for days and it was customary for the couple to have people around them for about a week, eating, and drinking. Mary noticed their wine had run out and immediately informed Jesus. She said, "They have no more wine" (v. 3). The information was not a request for money to buy more wine from Jesus, but an attestation of Mary's faith in Jesus to do the miraculous.

- How do you manage and maintain close relationship with someone higher in status compared to you?
- Do you think we need to pray to Jesus through Mary? John 14:13, John 15:7, John 15:16.

PRACTICAL LESSON: Believers must maximize every opportunity that we have to announce JESUS to the world.

C. THE PERSISTENT MOTHER.

JOHN 19:25-27

Mary went through the traumatic experience of preserving Jesus as a baby and tried her best to help as a mother all through His ministry. But when He was arrested, tried and crucified, the best she could do was to stand by and watch in the company of some other women (v. 25). It was probably then that she understood what Simeon had told her: "a sword will pierce your soul too" (Luke 2:35).

- Share some ways believers can treasure God's Word in their hearts during difficult times and how it can help them find courage and strength. Jer. 15:16, Psm.19:10, Psm.119:97
- How can parents be there for their children all through their lifetime?

PRACTICAL LESSON: This lesson challenges believers to trust God's plan and find strength in His Word when they feel helpless.
