SUNDAY SCHOOL STUDY OUTLINE

SEPT 06, 2026

THEME: FROM NOMADIC TRIBE TO SETTLED PEOPLE.

TOPIC: COVENANT CONTINUES.

TEXT: JOSHUA 1:1-11.

MEMORY VERSE: Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go.

JOSHUA 1:9.

INTRODUCTION:

Our lesson today will expose us to the continuation of God's covenant for his people.

A. GOD COMMISSIONED JOSHUA.

JOSHUA 1:1-5

Shortly after Moses died, God commissioned Joshua with a specific mandate to lead the Israelites across the Jordan River into the Promised Land, a task that requires urgent action and great faith. There are challenges notwithstanding, God's presence guaranteed success as Joshua had witnessed God's supremacy during their journey in the wilderness. God continues to commission His children for Kingdom assignments and Christians must be good followers and be ready to submit to training for God to make use of them.

- Why do some Christians give excuses when God calls them for the Kingdom assignment? Ex. 3:11; 4:1, 10-13.
- How does God's Commission to Joshua encourage or challenge your service in your local church? 1:5; Matt. 28:20

PRACTICAL LESSON: Believers must make themselves available for Kingdom business.

B. GOD INSTRUCTED JOSHUA.

JOSHUA 1:6-9

God provided Joshua with crucial instructions and guidance to prepare him for the conquest of the Promised Land. First, Joshua was commanded to be strong and courageous, and the directive was repeated three times (v 6-7, 9) to emphasize its importance. Success and prosperity in Joshua's mission would come from diligent reading, meditating on, and obeying God's command. Fear is a deadly enemy that can hinder the fulfillment of God's purpose in our lives, and as believers, we must not let it dominate us.

- Share experiences of how fear hindered you from enjoying the fulfillment of God's promise.
- How will you demonstrate courage and faith in God's words? James. 2:17

PRACTICAL LESSON: Victory and prosperity come from wholeheartedly obeying God and humbling ourselves to learn from his teachings.

C. JOSHUA'S RESPONSE.

JOSHUA 1:10-11.

Joshua's response to God's call demonstrated his:

- ✓ Immediate obedience and readiness to act on God's command.
- ✓ Understanding of the urgency and commitment to carrying out the Lord's business without delay.
- ✓ Trust in God.
- ✓ Administrative prowess.
- Mention two all three ways believers can respond appropriately to God's assignment today
- Suggest ways our local churches can help their leaders succeed with God's assignment. 1Tim. 2:2; Eph. 6:18-19.

PRACTICAL LESSON: Christians must demonstrate unwavering faith and trust in God, backing their faith with actions.
